## You will cover things like:

- promoting positive behaviour
- supporting pupils
- using information and communication technology
- helping with children's social development.

## Level 2 certificate is comprised of both mandatory and optional units, including:

- Safeguarding the welfare of children and young people (3 credits)
- Help improve own and team practice in schools (3 credits)
- Support children and young people's positive behaviour (2 credits)
- Provide displays in schools (3 credits)
- Provide support for therapy sessions (2 credits).

Assessment will be via assignments, case studies, observations of work practices, expert witness testimonies, simulation and professional discussion.
